Comments – This land was adjacent to/and at places included in, the village of Conwayborough.

Owners – John DuRant (Nov. 19, 1817 – 1,000 acs.), Capt. Henry DuRant (1821), William DuRant (1836), Col. James Beaty (1838).

Buildings – No buildings extant. Included on the plantation had been a DuRant Chapel.
